

Give these as possible scenario prompts to children:

- The new boy in class is playing on his own during recess. Tao sees him and feels bad, but he also wants to go play with his friends. What can he do?
- Melissa starts a new dance club with her friends. Her friend Jasmine wants to join, but her other friends say not to invite her. What should Melissa do?
- Tony saw some older kids bullying someone in the bathroom. He's scared that he would get hurt if he went to stop them. What can he do?
- Brian is having a difficult time keeping up in math class. He really doesn't like it and doesn't know what to do. What can he do?
- Min's friends want her to go to a party on a school night, but she knows her parents would say no. She really wants to go and is scared of getting in trouble. She is wondering if she should lie to her parents. What should she do?
- Kevin just had big fight with his friend Javinder. He is really mad at him. On his way home from school, he sees Javinder sitting on the sidewalk crying. It looks like he took a hard fall. What should Kevin do?
- Polly's soccer coach is treating her unfairly and says she is not a good player. Polly feels really bad, but is scared to tell her parents because she really likes her teammates and does not want to get kicked off the team. What should she do?
- Colin's class is going to the amusement park tomorrow. Although Colin handed in his permission form, he is afraid of heights and doesn't want to go on the rides. He doesn't want his friends to think he is a scaredy cat so he didn't say anything, but he really doesn't want to go. What should he do?
